WHAT HAS JESUS DONE?

- **He paid for our Healing.**

Isaiah 53:3-5 (KJV)

He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not.

4 Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. 5 But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

Isaiah 53:3-5 (Message Translation)

There was nothing attractive about him, nothing to cause us to take a second look. He was looked down on and passed over, a man who suffered, who knew pain firsthand. One look at him and people turned away. We looked down on him, thought he was scum. But the fact is, it was our pains he carried—our disfigurements, all the things wrong with us. We thought he brought it on himself, that God was punishing him for his own failures. But it was our sins that did that to him, that ripped and tore and crushed him—our sins! He took the punishment, and that made us whole. Through his bruises we get healed.

Isaiah 53:3-5 (Lexham English Bible)

He was despised and rejected by men, a man of suffering, and acquainted with [e] sickness, and like one from whom others hide their faces,[f] he was despised, and we did not hold him in high regard. However, he was the one who lifted up our sicknesses, and he carried our pain, yet [g] we ourselves assumed him stricken, struck down by God and afflicted. But [h] he was pierced [i] because of our transgressions, crushed because of our iniquities; the chastisement for [j] our peace [k] was upon him, and by his wounds [l] we were healed.[m]

- Your body has a price tag.

1 Corinthians 6:19-20 (KJV)

[19] What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? [20] For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

- It was paid in full and a new occupant moved in.

Romans 8:11 (KJV)

But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.

Every time you are sick, you are paying another price and allowing another occupant.

The Holy Spirit cannot occupy your body and the spirit of sickness also occupy the same body.

Luke 13:11 (KJV)

[11] And, behold, there was a woman which had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years, and was bowed together, and could in no wise lift up herself.

Sickness and disease makes you pay a new price with your body and money.

Luke 8:43-48 (KJV)

43 And a woman having an issue of blood twelve years, which had spent all her living upon physicians, neither could be healed of any, 44 Came behind him, and touched the border of his garment: and immediately her issue of blood stanch'd. 45 And Jesus said, Who touched me? When all denied, Peter and they that were with him said, Master, the multitude throng thee and press thee, and sayest thou, Who touched me? 46 And Jesus said, Somebody hath touched me: for I perceive that virtue is gone out of me. 47 And when the woman saw that she was not hid, she came trembling, and falling down before him, she declared unto him before all the people for what cause she had touched him, and how she was healed immediately. 48 And he said unto her, Daughter, be of good comfort: thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace.

Every time you are in Sound Health, your body is glorifying God.

1 Corinthians 6:19-20 (KJV)

[19] What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? [20] For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

He took our sicknesses because He already paid for our sicknesses.

Matthew 8:16-17 (KJV)

When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with his word, and healed all that were sick: 17 That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses.

1 Peter 2:24 (KJV)

Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.

Jesus is not just going to pay for our healing; Jesus already paid for our healing.

The same way and the same time Jesus carried our sins is the same way and same time Jesus carried our sicknesses.

If you can see the receipt of His payment, then you are a candidate for healing.

THE RECEIPT OF HIS PAYMENT WAS FILLED IN THREE (3) PLACES:

1. Heaven
2. Earth
3. Under the Earth

Philippians 2:8-11

He paid with His Blood, but the receipt is in His Name.

TWO (2) OF THE MOST DANGEROUS WEAPONS THE BELIEVER HAS ARE:

2. The Name of Jesus

1. Access is in the Name

John 14:6

6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me. No man cometh to the father except

John 16:23

And in that day ye shall ask me nothing. Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, he will give it you.

Proverbs 18:10

10 The Lord [b] is a strong fortress. The godly run to him and are safe.

Psalm 91:1-4
