### **Matthew 13:3-9**

*3 And he spake many things unto them in parables, saying, Behold, a sower went forth to sow; 4 And when he sowed, some seeds fell by the way side, and the fowls came and devoured them up: 5 Some fell upon stony places, where they had not much earth: and forthwith they sprung up, because they had no deepness of earth: 6 And when the sun was up, they were scorched; and because they had no root, they withered away. 7 And some fell among thorns; and the thorns sprung up, and choked them: 8 But other fell into good ground, and brought forth fruit, some an hundredfold, some sixtyfold, some thirtyfold. 9 Who hath ears to hear, let him hear.*

### **John 12:24-25**

*24 Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit. 25 He that loveth his life shall lose it; and he that hateth his life in this world shall keep it unto life eternal.*

Every seed has great potential.

There is greatness hidden in every seed. That includes you.

There is greatness in you.

While we all have the potentials for greatness, we are all exposed to dangers of littleness.

That a seed has the potential to be fruitful does not make it fruitful.

**Every seed must recognize this:**

You are born a seed to live life as a seed and to end up as a plantation with fruits.

**Matthew 13:8**

*8 But other fell into good ground, and brought forth fruit, some an hundredfold, some sixtyfold, some thirtyfold. 9 Who hath ears to hear, let him hear.*

## How do I move from being born as a seed to living life as a seed?

1. **Protect the Seed.** Once you know and understand that you are a seed, you will be careful about the things you expose yourself to. Learn to protect yourself from dangers of destiny. The things you allow will either enhance your seed or destroy your seed.

### Psalm 1:1-3

*Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.<sup>2</sup> But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night. And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.*

## **Psalm 1:1-3 (Message)**

*How well God must like you—  
you don't hang out at Sin Saloon,  
you don't slink along Dead-End Road,  
you don't go to Smart-Mouth College.  
2-3 Instead you thrill to GOD's Word,  
you chew on Scripture day and night.  
You're a tree replanted in Eden,  
bearing fresh fruit every month,  
Never dropping a leaf,  
always in blossom.*

The Psalm above shows how to protect your seed.

### **We are warned of the following:**

- a. Don't hang around the Sin Saloon
- b. Don't slink (glide) along a Dead-End Road
- c. Don't go to Smart-Mouth College

What a revelation this is.

Don't hang around the Sin Saloon. You cannot expose yourself to sin and protect your seed. Someone said, 'Every time man sins, something dies.' The number one destroyer of seed is sin.

Don't glide along a Dead-End Road, a road leading nowhere. Before you embark on a journey, confirm its destination. That is what the Word is for. The Word is our GPS. It shows you where you are and tells you what changes to make if you must arrive at the destination you had imputed.

We are also warned not to enroll in the Smart-Mouth College. This college accepts all candidates that apply because there are no requirements. You cannot hang around those pulling down other seeds with their mouths and expect your seed to blossom.

- 2. Grow the Seed.** This takes sacrifice. Jesus explained this in **John 12:24-25**. To grow the seed, you will require;
- a. Diligence
  - b. Sacrifice.

You have to diligently locate good ground, and then you have to sacrificially plant yourself in good ground.

**3. Invest in the Seed.** Until you are willing to make investments into the seed, you are not to expect any harvest or fruit or plantation from the seed.

**How do I move from living as a seed to becoming a Plantation, yielding fruits?**

- 1. Locate your ground.** You will never flourish until you locate your purpose as a seed. Only those planted on ‘good ground’ can yield. A seed is of no value without the ground.
- 2. Locate your kind of seed.** A good ground for a certain kind of seed is not the same for another kind of seed. This is where your uniqueness comes in. Even within the same family of seeds, everyone is unique. If you are a unique seed, you will also need a unique ground to flourish.



3. **Value your kind of seed.** It is one thing to locate your kind of seed and not treasure it. Until you value what you carry, no one else may value it. Locate your ministry. You are in ministry once you have discovered and are walking in purpose.
4. **Be sensitive to the seasons that favor your kind of seed.** Every wise farmer knows the power of times and seasons. **Genesis 8:22.**

Now that you have discovered these truths from God's Word, we must begin to walk in these discoveries.

How you handle your seed will determine your harvest.
