The truth is, as followers of Jesus, we have several advantages over the world.

Many followers of Jesus seem disadvantaged because they are yet to discover what I am about to share with you now.

When you discover the Anointing Advantage, you will stand out in every season of life.

What does it mean to be Anointed?

It is from the Greek word "*Chrio*." It means to put oil on your hands, turn it downwards and rub it into someone else.

It is a hands-on experience of the Holy Spirit. Knowing the Holy Spirit intimately will be another book on its own. For those who are yet to personally know the Holy Spirit, you will need to desire a personal encounter with Him. He is not a feeling or emotional display.

To be anointed is simply God laying His hands on you.

It is God's hand upon a person or a thing that makes all the difference. As followers of Jesus, we all have access to being anointed - 1 John 2:20/2 Corinth. 1:21

When you are anointed, the hand of God comes upon you to Help you - *Acts 26:22*

When you are anointed, the Grace of God comes to Enable you - *1 Corinth*. *15:10*

The Anointing is better experienced than described.

Scriptural Examples of those anointed include:

- 1. **Cyrus** *Is*. 45:1-3
- 2. Saul-ISam. 10:1-11
- 3. Uzziah 2 Chr. 26:3/15
- 4. **David** ISam. 16:13/21-23/24:6/10
- 5. **Jesus** *Is*. 61:1-3/Lk. 4:18-21/Acts 10:38
- 6. **Paul** I Corinth. 15:10/Acts 26:22

We must recognize that it is the Holy Spirit in the oil that turns the Olive Oil to the Anointing Oil - 1 Samuel 16:13

Mark 6:7/12-13

12And he called unto him the twelve, and began to send them forth by two and two; and gave them power over unclean spirits;

And they went out, and preached that men should repent.

13 And they cast out many devils, and anointed with oil many that were sick, and healed them.

James 5:13-15

13 Is any among you afflicted? let him pray. Is any merry? let him sing psalms.

14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:

15 And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he hath committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

Without understanding the person of the Holy Spirit, the Oil may not give the advantage it was intended to.

Personal requirements for the Anointing:

- 1. **Consecrate yourself.** The Holy Spirit does not just jump on anybody. The Holy Spirit does not have value for a vessel that is not given to a life of purity. *2 Timothy 2:19-21*. In this context, to consecrate yourself means to separate yourself. To be anointed by the Holy Spirit, we must stay away from things that will not glorify God.
- 2. **Humble yourself** 2 Chronicles 26:3/15-23. Have a control valve for your life. Pride is of the heart and not of the face. Looking gentle doesn't equal humility. The story of a young boy was once told. This boy was being disciplined by his mother. He was told to sit down several times but refused. He finally did and when he did, his mother commended him for sitting down. The little boy responded, 'I am sitting on the outside but standing

on the inside.' We must learn to humble ourselves under the mighty power of God so that He can lift us up.

- 3. **Discover yourself.** This means we must locate His plan and purpose for our lives. *Jeremiah* 1:5/ *Galatians* 1:15-16, 1 *Corinthians* 15:10. Everyone is created and anointed for a purpose. When you are in your purpose, you enjoy His help and Grace.
- 4. **Locate yourself.** This means we must find our company and belong there. When you locate a vessel, who carries the grace you desire, connect with them without delay. Do not destroy the grace you desire to build you up. It is only those who have the intention of doing good that will be anointed. *I Samuel* 10:1-11

- It is Preventive 1 Chronicles 16:22 Psalm 105:15
- It is Curative James 5:14-15
- It is Creative Job 33:4
- It is Destructive Isaiah 10:27

Expect that by the Anointing of the Holy Spirit, you have an advantage in times that we are in.
