This book is one that I consider so relevant to the times that we live in. In the midst of the current global health crisis, COVID-19, it is important to catch a revelation of the responsibility placed on us as sons and daughters of God.

Romans 8:19

For the earnest expectation of the creature waiteth for the manifestation of the sons of God.

This is not the time for us to weep.

If we weep, we will be whipped by these circumstances.

To fully carry out our responsibilities, it is required that we embrace the supernatural.

Embracing the reality of the Supernatural is key to Commanding the Supernatural.

It should be clear by now to everyone reading this that we live in a wicked and evil world.

1 John 5:19

19 And we know that we are of God, and the whole world lieth in wickedness.

However, no matter how wicked darkness is, it will bow to light.

The wickedness of darkness is no match for the authority of light.



The Command of the Supernatural is at the Command of Revelation.

Look at the scripture below and catch a glimpse of what God has commissioned all His sons and daughters to do within a crisis like this.

Psalms 82:5-7 (King James Version)

They know not, neither will they understand; they walk on in darkness: all the foundations of the earth are out of course. 6 I have said, Ye are gods; and all of you are children of the Most High. 7 But ye shall die like men, and fall like one of the princes.

Psalm 82:5-7 (Classic Amplified)

[The magistrates and judges] know not, neither will they understand; they walk on in the darkness [of complacent satisfaction]; all the foundations of the earth [the fundamental principles upon which rests the administration of justice] are shaking. I said, You are gods [since you judge on My behalf, as My representatives]; indeed, all of you are children of the Most High. 7 But you shall die as men and fall as one of the princes.

Psalm 82:5-7 (Message Translation)

Ignorant judges! Head-in-the-sand judges!

They haven't a clue to what's going on.

And now everything's falling apart, the world's coming unglued.

I commissioned you judges, each one of you, deputies of the High God,

But you've betrayed your commission

and now you're stripped of your rank, busted."



Every Child of God has been ‘Commissioned’ as a Judge.

If you catch a glimpse of this revelation, it will lead to a revolution in your life.

We are not victims of circumstances but judges of circumstances.

Even though we have been commissioned, we will require the right revelation to function.

A commission without revelation will end in frustration.

What I am sharing with you came as an encounter I had as I prepared to minister in a Sunday Service on how to command the Supernatural.

Look very closely from this point on in this book.

The Supernatural is not commanded accidentally but intentionally.

To judge on God’s behalf, He gave you the following;

- 1. His Name.** We were given the Name of Jesus so that we can do as occasion serves us. The Name of Jesus is not just to be used in prayers but to be used in judgement. Now that we have His Name, whatever answers to Him, answers to us.

Mark 16:17-18

And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and

if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

- 2. His Word.** The Word is not just for us to read and quote. It is a sure guarantee from God. He has guaranteed that He will always stand by His Word. That is a guarantee we can go to bed with. Forever, His Word will always be settled.

Matthew 5:18

18 For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled.

Jeremiah 20:9

9 Then I said, I will not make mention of him, nor speak any more in his name. But his word was in mine heart as a burning fire shut up in my bones, and I was weary with forbearing, and I could not stay.

- 3. His Blood.** His blood is not just for drinking as we have it with the Communion. It is a gift Jesus gave to us. With His blood at work in us and for us, we have the right to judge on His behalf.

Ephesians 2:13

But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ.



Hebrews 9:14

How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

4. **His Body.** While we take His flesh and blood in the Communion, we really are partaking of His life. Just like Jesus judged on His Fathers' behalf, we have also been sent as judges.

Leviticus 17:11

11 For the life of the flesh is in the blood: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls: for it is the blood that maketh an atonement for the soul.

5. **His Spirit.** The same Spirit that was in Christ while He was here on the earth is the same Holy Spirit that has been given to us. When the Holy Spirit showed up in Acts, Chapter 2, He manifested Himself as the Spirit of Judgement in Acts, Chapter 5.

Acts 5:3-11

3 But Peter said, Ananias, why hath Satan filled thine heart to lie to the Holy Ghost, and to keep back part of the price of the land? 4 Whiles it remained, was it not thine own? and after it was sold, was it not in thine own power? why hast thou conceived this thing in thine heart? thou hast not lied unto men, but unto God. 5 And Ananias hearing these words fell down, and gave up the ghost; and great fear came on all them that heard these things. 6 And the young men



arose, wound him up, and carried him out, and buried him. 7 And it was about the space of three hours after, when his wife, not knowing what was done, came in. 8 And Peter answered unto her, Tell me whether ye sold the land for so much? And she said, Yea, for so much. 9 Then Peter said unto her, How is it that ye have agreed together to tempt the Spirit of the Lord? behold, the feet of them which have buried thy husband are at the door, and shall carry thee out. 10 Then fell she down straightway at his feet, and yielded up the ghost: and the young men came in, and found her dead, and, carrying her forth, buried her by her husband. 11 And great fear came upon all the church, and upon as many as heard these things.

Romans 8:11

But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.

1 John 4:13

Hereby know we that we dwell in him, and he in us, because he hath given us of his Spirit.

2 Corinthians 5:5

5 Now he that hath wrought us for the selfsame thing is God, who also hath given unto us the earnest of the Spirit.



See these 5 things mentioned above as requirements for you to sit in the judgement seat.

1. **His Name** – The Hammer. When the name is applied, desires are granted.

John 14:13

13 And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

Acts 3:3-6

Who seeing Peter and John about to go into the temple asked an alms.

4 And Peter, fastening his eyes upon him with John, said, Look on us.

5 And he gave heed unto them, expecting to receive something of them.

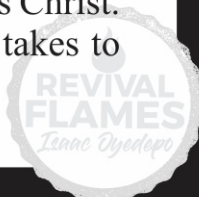
6 Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk.

2. **His Word** – The Constitution. The Word of God is the constitution upon which judgement is carried out. Even though we are judges on His behalf, He has given us the constitution upon which to judge by.

1 John 5:14

14 And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us:

3. **His Blood** – The White Shirt. We are of the same bloodline as Jesus Christ. This connects us to Jesus who is our perfect example on what it takes to judge or change the situations of life.



Leviticus 17:11

11 For the life of the flesh is in the blood: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls: for it is the blood that maketh an atonement for the soul.

- 4. His Body** – The Robe. He gave body His body to further validate that He has given us His all. His body and His blood also guarantee that we are in a hurt free zone as we carry out judgment on His behalf.
- 5. His Spirit** – The Wig. This is what happened on the day of Pentecost. The Holy Spirit came upon them. The Wig signifies the Spirit upon. This is relevant for us to carry out judgement over the circumstances of life.

John 16:8

And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:

Now, have a look at things not going exactly the way you desire and change them by revelation you have just received.

This is a call to action for all ‘dead judges.’ By this I mean, we must arise and awake to take charge of our jurisdiction.

God is Judge of all the earth; we are judges of our corners of the earth.

I sense there is an army rising that will not be conformed to this world, but will be transformed by this revelation from God.
