**Galatians 3:1 (KJV)**

*O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you?*

**Galatians 3:1 (Message)**

*You crazy Galatians! Did someone put a hex on you? Have you taken leave of your senses? Something crazy has happened, for it's obvious that you no longer have the crucified Jesus in clear focus in your lives. His sacrifice on the cross was certainly set before you clearly enough.*

We have seen too much of God to doubt God.

We have seen first-hand the labor of the previous generation that has led to generational impact.



## **Joshua 1:1-9 (KJV)**

*Now after the death of Moses the servant of the LORD it came to pass, that the LORD spake unto Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' minister, saying,<sup>2</sup> Moses my servant is dead; now therefore arise, go over this Jordan, thou, and all this people, unto the land which I do give to them, even to the children of Israel.<sup>3</sup> Every place that the sole of your foot shall tread upon, that have I given unto you, as I said unto Moses.<sup>4</sup> From the wilderness and this Lebanon even unto the great river, the river Euphrates, all the land of the Hittites, and unto the great sea toward the going down of the sun, shall be your coast.<sup>5</sup> There shall not any man be able to stand before thee all the days of thy life: as I was with Moses, so I will be with thee: I will not fail thee, nor forsake thee.<sup>6</sup> Be strong and of a good courage: for unto this people shalt thou divide for an inheritance the land, which I swear unto their fathers to give them.<sup>7</sup> Only be thou strong and very courageous, that thou mayest observe to do according to all the law, which Moses my servant commanded thee: turn not from it to the right hand or to the left, that thou mayest prosper withersoever thou goest.<sup>8</sup> This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make*



*thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success.<sup>9</sup> Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the LORD thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest.*

**Joshua 1:1-9 (Message)**

*After the death of Moses the servant of GOD, GOD spoke to Joshua, Moses' assistant: "Moses my servant is dead. Get going. Cross this Jordan River, you and all the people. Cross to the country I'm giving to the People of Israel. I'm giving you every square inch of the land you set your foot on—just as I promised Moses. From the wilderness and this Lebanon east to the Great River, the Euphrates River—all the Hittite country—and then west to the Great Sea. It's all yours. All your life, no one will be able to hold out against you. In the same way I was with Moses, I'll be with you. I won't give up on you; I won't leave you. Strength! Courage! You are going to lead this people to inherit the land that I promised to give their ancestors. Give it everything you have, heart and soul. Make sure you carry out The Revelation that Moses commanded you, every bit of it. Don't get off track, either left or right, so as to make sure you get to where you're going. And don't for a minute let this Book of The Revelation be out of mind.*

***Ponder and meditate on it day and night, making sure you practice everything written in it. Then you'll get where you're going; then you'll succeed. Haven't I commanded you? Strength! Courage! Don't be timid; don't get discouraged. GOD, your God, is with you every step you take."***

The inspiration to write this letter is from the above scripture.

The Moses generation does not have to depart for the Joshua generation to arise.

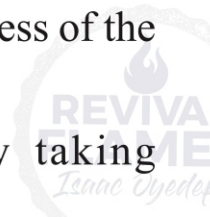
The Moses generation does not have to fail for the Joshua generation to arise.

**There are a few things to learn about the Joshua generation from the above scripture.**

1. **The Joshua Generation has to connect with God.** While Joshua was with Moses, Joshua was also with God. This is why He could hear God when God spoke. For the Joshua generation to truly arise, we must truly walk with God. Do not join the group that has redefined sin. Whatever displeased God still displeases God. His standards have not changed.
2. **The Joshua Generation has to connect with Mentors.** In the Mandate to Joshua, there was a lot of reference to His mentor – Moses. Our generation needs to get rid of pride and embrace humility. While our generation has a new approach for every old approach, a new approach is not always the better approach. It is time for us to pay very close observation to the revelations of the previous generation in order to gain our position in this generation.
3. **The Joshua Generation connects with Purpose.** Joshua had to encounter purpose for him to be useful in his generation. He got his task directly from God. He was not called by men to lead men but was called by God to lead men.

4. **The Joshua Generation connects with Observation.** Joshua had observed Moses but now God commanded him to do what he observed.
5. **The Joshua Generation connects with Courage.** There is no way to be used of God in this generation without risk. It is risky not to take risks.

There are several things the Moses generation has seen that the Joshua generation will experience.

The Moses generation is visionary so the Joshua generation must be *'actionary.'*

The Joshua generation has no excuse at failure.

If we fail, we have failed God and the Moses generation.

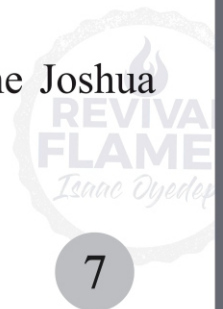
It is time for the Joshua generation to arise and shine.
