

The Word of God is what we are to live by.

## Matthew 4:4

But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.

Many who have heard the Word have not learnt to live by the Word because they have not learnt how to process the Word.

In a season like this, it is important that the Word is not only heard, but that the Word is also processed.

This why we have called the title of this release: "Word Factory."

The question to be asked is, "What do I do when I hear the Word or read the Word?"

The raw word must be processed for it to result in proofs.

This is why we can read the same scripture, have different pictures, and have different results.

If we will not subject ourselves to the same process, we cannot have the same product.

#### THE WORD PROCESSING PLANT

#### 1. Receive the Word.

John 1:1-5 (King James Version)

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 The same was in the beginning with God. 3 All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made. 4 In him was life; and the life was the light of men. 5 And the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not.

John 1:12 (King James Version)

But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name:

The Word that is not received cannot be processed.

The raw material of the Word has to be received before it can be processed.

As long as it is the Word of God, it can turn around the world of a man.

## 2. Believe the Word.

# Mark 16:15-20 (King James Version)

And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. 16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. 17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover. 19 So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, he was received up into heaven, and sat on the right hand of God. 20 And they went forth, and preached everywhere, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.

# Mark 16:15-20 (Message Translation)

Then he said, "Go into the world. Go everywhere and announce the Message of God's good news to one and all. Whoever believes and is baptized is saved; whoever refuses to believe is damned. 17-18 "These are some of the signs that will accompany believers: They will throw out demons in my name, they will speak in new tongues, they will take snakes in their hands, they will drink poison and not be hurt, they will lay hands on the sick and make them well." 19-20 Then the Master

Jesus, after briefing them, was taken up to heaven, and he sat down beside God in the place of honor. And the disciples went everywhere preaching, the Master working right with them, validating the Message with indisputable evidence.

The next step after you receive the Word is to believe the Word.

The Word received is easily believed.

If God says it, it is authentic enough to believe it.

## 3. Obey the Word.

John 2:5-11 (King James Version)

His mother saith unto the servants, Whatsoever he saith unto you, do it. 6 And there were set there six waterpots of stone, after the manner of the purifying of the Jews, containing two or three firkins apiece. 7 Jesus saith unto them, Fill the waterpots with water. And they filled them up to the brim. 8 And he saith unto them, Draw out now, and bear unto the governor of the feast. And they bare it. 9 When the ruler of the feast had tasted the water that was made wine, and knew not whence it was: (but the servants which drew the water knew;) the governor of the feast called the bridegroom, 10 And saith unto him, Every man at the beginning doth set forth good wine; and when men

have well drunk, then that which is worse: but thou hast kept the good wine until now. 11 This beginning of miracles did Jesus in Cana of Galilee, and manifested forth his glory; and his disciples believed on him.

The next step after you believe the Word is to obey the Word.

Negotiating obedience is negotiating your command of the supernatural.

Until you do the ridiculous, you cannot command the miraculous.

The Supernatural is simply a product of our obedience of faith.

## 4. Speak the Word.

## **John 3:8**

The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit.



## Mark 11:23

For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

The final step is to speak the Word.

The Word you receive, believe, and obey, you will have no problem speaking publicly.

It is the sound of faith we make that determines the signs and wonders we command.

The Supernatural is the manifestation of the Word we receive, believe, obey, and speak that God confirms into signs and wonders.

# Isaiah 29:11-12 (King James Version)

And the vision of all is become unto you as the words of a book that is sealed, which men deliver to one that is learned, saying, Read this, I pray thee: and he saith, I cannot; for it is sealed: 12 And the book is delivered to him that is not learned, saying, Read this, I pray thee: and he saith, I am not learned.

James 1:23 (King James Version)

23 For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass:

The Word must be processed for the product of the Supernatural to become a reality!!!

My challenge to you today is to process the Word you have received thus far, and it will end as a product.

The world is tired of our explanation. It is time for manifestation.
